

## **SEWING CONTEST – 2009**

### **WASHINGTON STATE GRANGE CWA DEPARTMENT**

#### **WHAT TO ENTER**

##### **Group I - Adults Outer Garments**

Class A: Adults Sewing for Adult. Garments made by contestant 19 years or older for self or another adult.

Class B: Adults Sewing for Children. Garments made by contestant 19 years or older for children.

Class C: Coats & Jackets. Garment must be lined.

##### **Group II - Juniors and Teens**

Class D: Teens 14 to 18. Any sewn item made by teen age 14 to 18.

Class E: Boys and Girls age 10 to 13. Any sewn item made by boys and girls age 10 to 13.

Class F: Boys and Girls age 9 and under. Any sewn item made by a boy or girl age 9 and under.

##### **Group III - Specialty**

Class G: Lingerie. To include PJs, Nighties, Robes.

Class H: Miscellaneous. Any sewing item that doesn't fit into any other class. Can be baby bibs, shopping bag, place mats, dinner bun holder, Christmas tree skirt, etc.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Grange members and non-members may enter.

All work must be entirely that of the contestant and the work must be completed in the current contest year.

Any pattern may be used and need not be current or that of a commercial company. If an entry is an original idea, sufficient documentation must be provided.

Entries may be a single item or coordinated separates.

Coordinated separates must be limited to four pieces.

A person may submit any number of entries on the Subordinate/Pomona level, but all must be entered through one subordinate Grange.

Only one entry per person per class will be allowed for state judging.

Contestants must abide by the judges decision, contest rules, and their interpretation.

#### **JUDGING**

Entries judged on the basis of general appearance, creativity and the added touches and workmanship.

#### **AWARDS**

State awards in each class are: First place \$20, Second place \$15, Third place \$10 except Classes D, E, and F which are: First \$12, Second \$11, Third \$10.

#### **ENTRY FORM**

Complete general CWA entry form. Fold bottom portion upward on fold like and pin with safety pin (no straight pins) so that only group and class are visible. Sew entry form onto the outside back of the entry.

Submit the pattern envelope and instruction sheet, or documentation, inside a 6 1/2 " x 9 1/2" envelope. On the outside of the envelope, print the following information:
